What time does the evening reception begin and end?

The reception will be held from 7:00 P.M. –10:00 P.M.

Where is the reception being held?

National Air & Space Museum, 600 Independence Ave SW, Washington, DC 20560

Is there a dress code?

Yes, Dress is Black Tie Optional: cocktail/business attire.

Do I need a ticket to attend?

Yes. Please bring your electronic or printed invitation confirmation, which will be scanned upon entry.

Will dinner be served?

The reception includes heavy hors d'oeuvres and drinks.

Are dietary options available?

Yes, vegetarian and vegan selections will be available.

Is there an open bar or cash bar?

Enjoy our complimentary open bar, plus non-alcoholic beverages.

What kind of entertainment will there be?

A string quartet will be playing during the reception.

Is parking available?

No. There is no parking at the Museum. Parking can be reserved in the general vicinity through [SpotHero](#) or [ParkWhiz](#). ATCA does not endorse any of the parking sites listed.

What is the best form of transportation?

Due to the lack of parking at the venue, we encourage our guests to use Uber, Lyft, or alternate transportation.

Can I bring a guest?

Guests are welcome but a ticket must be purchased in advance.

Is there an age restriction?

Yes, attendees must be 21 or older.

Will seating be provided?

Yes, limited seating will be available throughout the venue. A mix of cocktail tables and highboys will be provided but this is a “wandering” reception meant for guests to walk around to enjoy the Museum’s newly renovated exhibits and displays. In addition, limited seating will be available during the award ceremony.

Will photographers be present?

Yes, professional photos will be taken and may be used in future promotions. Guests will have the option of taking a photo on the red carpet for remembrance.

Can I leave and re-enter?

Yes, re-entry is allowed with an invitation pass.
